Dear Parent/Carer

The science department is running a residential trip to CERN, the European Organisation for Nuclear Research in Geneva, Switzerland.

The trip is due to depart Sunday 12 July 2020 and return Tuesday 14 July 2020. These dates are subject to change, depending on availability of flights and the tour around the CERN facilities. Places are limited to 20 students and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

The cost for the trip is currently quoted at £320 per person, including UK airport transfers, return flights and bed and breakfast accommodation. Activities in Geneva will include a Lake Geneva boat trip, as well as the visit to the CERN facilities. Entry to CERN is free of charge and the Lake Geneva boat tour is included in the price quoted above. Additional money will be needed for any food and/or activities the students would like to do once in Geneva. We aim to eat out as a group; information regarding this will follow in due course.

To secure a place on the trip a deposit of £100 is required by Monday 14 October 2019. A second payment of £75 per student is required 4 weeks after booking, with the final balance due 10 weeks prior to departure. A reminder will be sent to you nearer to these dates.
