Dear Parent/Carer

The Year 12 public services group are currently planning an expedition to Snowdon in June. In preparation for this, there are several walks planned to improve their hill walking fitness and navigation skills. The second of these walks is planned for Thursday 16 January 2020. Please avoid giving your son/daughter bagged nuts or products with a nut content, as even the smell can cause these students anxiety.**
