Dear Parent/Carer

I am pleased to be able to offer your child the opportunity to attend the Year 7 habitats and adaptations trip to Twycross Zoo, Atherstone, taking place on Wednesday 12 February 2020. This trip will support the Year 7 science curriculum.

The cost per student is £15, which includes return coach travel and entrance to the zoo. There will be a number of activities which are linked to the new Activate curriculum which is being taught this year. We will be leaving school at 9.00am and returning to school at approximately 3.00pm.

Please be aware that we have students who may be participating in this trip who have a serious nut allergy. **Please avoid giving your son/daughter bagged nuts or products with a nut content, as even the smell can cause these students anxiety.** If your child is entitled to free school meals and requires a packed lunch on the day please inform us via ParentPay when you pay and give consent. Students who do not wish to go on this trip will be expected to attend school as normal, and will take part in school based habitats and adaptations activities.
