Your daughter has an opportunity to participate in a science enrichment competition, GO4SET, which is organised by EDT in association with global industry leaders such as Rolls-Royce, Eon and GSK. This is a fantastic opportunity for students to participate in science-related activities, which will provide them with skills for the future both in and out of this sector. It will be an invaluable experience for those interested in broadening their team working skill set and provide opportunities to interact with professionals in industry, university staff and students from other schools.

In addition, students will receive an Industrial Cadets at IC Bronze Level Award. Industrial Cadets is an industry-led quality standard, inspired by HRH The Prince of Wales, which is designed to address skill shortages in industry and prepare the future workforce. The competition requires teams to attend a launch event at East Midlands Airport on **Monday 2 March 2020**, followed by weekly team meetings (1 hour per week) and an assessment/graduation day in June. This project requires commitment from staff, industry representatives and, most importantly, students.
